Overview:

- Venture Advisors from the stake teach Venturer and other Priest age youth how to lead a successful Venturer
- Venturing is the Church program for young men ages 16 through 18
- There is significant unit specific interaction between youth and his Advisor throughout the training session
- Designed to teach the Priests how to have a successful youth lead Venturer program
- How to seamlessly integrate the Duty to God Program with the Venturer program
- Long range program planning
- Quarterly program design
- The Venturer program is significantly different than Varsity
- Completion of this course qualifies the youth to wear the “Trained” patch

Who Should Attend – Youth:

All Priest quorum members and priest-aged non-members when:

- Joining the quorum or Crew or have not taken the training
- Receiving a new calling in quorum
- Getting a new Crew position
- Annually thereafter

Who Should Attend – Adults:

- Venturer Advisor/assistant needs to be in attendance anytime one of the Priests is present
- New adults to program

Adults who should attend at least once:

- Bishop/Branch President
- Crew committee members
- Priest quorum advisor
- Interested parents and other adults

How often is course provided?

Each spring and each fall
